

**INDIAN HILL RECREATION COMMISSION
MINUTES FOR APRIL 03, 2007**

I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Tim McKay at 7:35pm. Attendees were Tim McKay, John Blazic, Eppa Rixey, Keith Rabenold, Dan Robinette, John McClure, Steve Misali, Doug Howe, Anne Stokley, Rick Margraf, Moira Granger, Tom Powers, and Bruce Ferguson.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes were read and approved by Steve Misali and seconded by Tom Powers

III. VILLAGE REPORT

The Village report was provided by Eppa Rixey. There was no change from our last meeting.

IV. TREASURER'S REPORT

The Treasurer's report was provided by Dan Robinette which we had all received by email and there was no questions on that.

V. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- Basketball – by Doug Howe. Three awards were given. The two coach's awards went to Terry Dammeyer and Dave Boone. He also gave a certificate to a high school student, Dave Knowles, for his work.
- Lacrosse – no report given.
- Soccer – by Bruce Ferguson. They have 252 boys and 196 girls. New fields are being used at Kugler Mill and games start the week of April 14, 2007. They have hired a trainer for this year. They are doing a girls versus boys coaches Saturday, April 7, 2007 at Camp D. This summer, there are 2 different camps, one being run by the high school coaches at Indian Hill in June and another will be run July 11-15, 2007 by some trainers and coaches from England.
- Cross Country – no report given.
- Baseball – by Steve Misali. They have 18 teams and 225 children and their games start April 14,2007.
- Softball – by Anne Stokley. They are starting practice this week and games start the first weekend in May. They were also able to get their late games in June rescheduled.
- Tennis – by Moira Grainger. The flyers went out this week and signups will

- begin May 1, 2007.
- Cheerleading - no report.
- T-ball – by Steve Misali. There are 5 teams and 65 children. They start practice this week and games start April 21, 2007.
- Track – Matt McKee was not here but Jack stated that the first track meet is April 14, 2007 and he has lots of parental help.

VI. COORDINATOR REPORT

The coordinator report was given by Jack Alley. Work on Livingston restrooms is coming along. There was a long discussion about the parking issue at Camp Dennison fields where three weeks ago there were some parking issues due to a tournament that was held there with extra games. Greg Gould will look into changing the schedule so that the games don't overlap so much to see if we can work this out. A lightening detection system is operable at all 3 fields, Livingston, Camp Dennison and Stephen Field. Once they sound, we will clear the fields and wait 15 minutes to call the Ranger dispatcher to see if it is then permissible to return to the playing fields.

VII. OLD BUSINESS

Select in Rec – Tom Powers discussed the last meeting of that group. Minor changes were made in the guidelines to allow more flexibility. Also, a few ideas were provided that would improve future tryouts. We discussed having the children interested in Select pay at the beginning during regular signups to avoid non-payment. Also, the coaches' dinner is going to be held Sunday, May 20, 2007 at 5pm and Scott Rogers will be our speaker.

VIII. NEW BUSINESS

Anne Stokley introduced Keith Rabenold as a possible new member for the Rec Commission and this will be voted on at the next meeting. He is a long time resident of Indian Hill, has coached numerous teams, and has been on the Green Area Committee. Steve Misali suggested that AED's be placed at the fields and also talked about the possibility of offering CPR courses and first aid courses for coaches. There was some discussion about this issue and this will be discussed at further meetings. Fall signups for fall sports will be Saturday, May 05 and 12, 2007 at the middle school. This will be for fall cheerleading and soccer.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by John McClure and seconded by Doug Howe and it was adjourned at 8:40pm. The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, May 07, 2007 at 7:30pm.
