

**INDIAN HILL RECREATION COMMISSION
MINUTES FOR FEBRUARY 05, 2007**

I. CALL TO ORDER

President Tom Bolser called the meeting to order at 7:35pm. Attendees were Tom Bolser, Eppa Rixey, John Blazic, Ted Lucien, Greg Goold, Steve Misali, John McClure, Mark Feitlinger, Anne Stokley, Leigh Anne Meurer, Moira Granger, Tom Powers, Dan Robinett, and Bruce Ferguson.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes were approved by Mark Feitlinger and seconded by Steve Misali.

III. VILLAGE REPORT

The Village report was provided by Eppa Rixey. He discussed the meeting he and John Blazic had regarding possible future facilities which might include Cross Country Layout, an all purpose field with an all-weather surface, and possibly an indoor facility for basketball, swimming and workouts. The last two items were the long term facilities.

IV. TREASURER'S REPORT

The Treasurer's report was provided by Dan Robinett by email. He feels that we have approximately \$10,000.00 in the base amount of money that is in the treasury.

V. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- Basketball – by John Blazic as Doug Howe was not here. They have games to make up from the snow weekend in January and these will be made up involving teams that have a chance of finishing 1st or 2nd place.
- Lacrosse – by Greg Goold. Teams are set and practice starts February 20, 2007. The fields will be lined in the next two weeks. He has seven teams with 3 girls teams and 4 boys teams. The girls are 3rd and 4th grade, 5th grade, and 6th grade. The boys are kindergarten through 2nd, 3rd and 4th, 5th and 6th grade. There is a 7th and 8th grade team that is coached by Tim McKay. Mike Lewis has a Club Team of 7th and 8th grade boys that is outside the Rec program and Steve Hilmer has the girls 7th and 8th grade Club Team. We plan to take over the girls 7th and 8th grade teams next year and probably the boys 7th and 8th grade teams the following year.

- Soccer – by Bruce Ferguson. Soccer did decide to use the Corner Kick Software and will use that for team selection. They are not sure of the exact counts yet. Bruce proposed that a summer camp be done in the last week of July and the beginning of August that would be available for 1st through 8th graders. This would probably be done at Camp Livingston. He also discussed the possibility of having a soccer trainer be available for several practices during the year, similar to what is done in basketball.
- Cross Country – no report.
- Baseball – by Steve Misali. He has 220 children signed up and has 18 teams. He has 36 or more coaches available. Indian Hill plays in District 6 and he will be taking over the supervisor position of that district as the previous supervisor that has been there for a long time is stepping down. John McClure and Mark Feitlinger will help him run baseball this year and then he will find a new coordinator next year.
- Softball – by Anne Stokley. She has 4 teams and 4 coaches. Last year there were 5 teams.
- Tennis – by Moira Granger. She will start the promotion for tennis in March. The tennis sessions start the week after school is out. She had approximately 70-80 children last year and would hope to do that many this year. She also discussed updating the website for the tennis information.
- Cheerleading – by Leigh Anne Meurer. She is going to do this for the fall of 2007 but will be looking for a replacement for 2008. She also needs an administrator to help her as Kelly ??? is retiring.
- T-ball – by Mark Feitlinger. He has 61 players and only 2 coaches at this time. He needs hopefully 2 more. Last year we had 90 players that played t-ball but the district is down and the numbers for grades 1 through 3 are down.
- Track – no report.

VI. COORDINATOR REPORT

The coordinator report was given by Jack Alley. Chet Wiggins has retired from the school district after 27 plus years. Ken Stegaman is replacing him. A motion was made and seconded to send a letter of commendation to Chet for the great work he has performed for us over the years and to provide him with a gift certificate in the amount of \$100.00 to a local restaurant. Dick Bethel is providing a luncheon for the service department again this year. Jack provided us with a list of updated fees, the calendar for the upcoming year, and the membership list. At this time, the only sport that is interactive on our website is soccer and he discussed the possibility of other sports becoming interactive on our website. Also, the conference room behind the Indian Hill Village Hall is now available for small groups and if anyone is interested, they can contact Jack.
